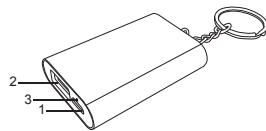

How to use

Instructions:

1. Charging the portable Power bank.

- Connect a USB charging cable to your phone's USB adapter. Using the Micro USB connector, connect the other end of the USB cable into the IN port on the portable Power bank. Then plug the USB adapter into the outlet to begin charging.
- Using your computer. Connect a USB cable to a USB port on your computer. Using the Micro USB connector, insert the other end of the USB cable to an IN port of the portable Power Bank. Make sure the computer is on to begin charging the portable Power bank.

2. Charging smartphones and other electronic devices.

- The portable power bank has a USB output port which has the maximum output current of 1000mA.
 - Connect a USB charging cable to your smartphone/ device using the appropriate connector. Insert the other end of the USB cable to the OUT port of the portable Power bank. Your mobile smartphone/device should display the status of charging.
 - Remove the USB cable from your mobile device when it is fully charged.
- Note: In order to charge device use only accessory cable (included with power bank) or the cable included with your own device by the manufacturer.

IMPORTANT SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

WARNING - When using this product, basic precautions should always be followed, including the following:

- Read all the instructions before using the product.
- Power bank main unit contains an internal lithium ion battery. Full charge power bank prior to initial use and after a prolonged storage period. The unit's full performance is achieved only after 2 or 3 completed charge and discharge cycles.
- Power banks are not allowed in checked luggage on commercial airline flights. Handle with care and dispose of in accordance to local regulations. Carry-on only.
- To reduce the risk of injury, close supervision is necessary - when the product is used near children.
- Do not put fingers or hands into the product.
- Do not expose power bank to rain or snow.
- Use of a power supply or charger not recommended or sold by power pack manufacturer may result in a risk of fire or injury to persons.

- Do not use the power bank in excess of its output rating. Overload outputs above rating may result in a risk of fire or injury to persons.
